First Term Attrition rates from 1986 – 2004

Percentage of first term missionaries who left AGWM before the end of their first term.

- 1986 – 1990: 17% (99 individuals)
- 1991 – 1995: 10% (50)
- 1996 – 2000: 6% (25)
- 2001 – 2004: 1% (4) (Incomplete cycle)

Reasons for this downward trend include:

- More focus on selection and training; 1990
- Missionary Associates program
- More focus regarding on-field training.
- More focus on helping candidates raise their budgets: first full time Itineration Manager, 1996
- Three year first terms begin; 1996-97
- Districts begin Fast Track and Jump Start programs for candidates; 1997-98
- Senders Fund established; 1997-98 (built on Cash for Candidates - 1992 and Global Thrust – 1995)
